## Kindergarten Entrance Expectations

### Reading Readiness

- Identifies name
- Prints name
- Understands reading left to right
- Recites alphabet
- Knows address/phone
- Knows age/birthday
- Understands rhyming words

### Math Readiness

- Recognizes primary colors
- Names shapes - triangle, rectangle, square, and circle
- Counts at least ten objects
- Identifies numbers 1-10
- Sorts by color, size, or type

### Social Emotional

- Shares
- Sits and listens for up to 5 minutes
- Expresses self verbally
- Cares for belongings
- Uses manners - please, thank you
- Takes care of toileting needs
- Respects peers during structured play

### Listening & Sequencing

- Follows simple directions
- Retells a simple story in sequence
- Listens and responds to simple questions

### Motor Skills

- Runs
- Walks a straight line
- Jumps
- Hops
- Stands on one foot
- Throws a ball
- Buttons and zips
- Builds with blocks
- Draws and colors using three finger grip
- Uses scissors
- Ties shoes

*I.C. 20-33-2-7 established a statewide entrance eligibility date for public school kindergarten.
