



## ISTEP+ and IREAD-3 2012-2013

The purpose of this document is to describe similarities and differences regarding *ISTEP+* and *IREAD-3* to help parents and schools better understand the Spring 2013 statewide assessments for Indiana’s third graders.

*IREAD-3* and *ISTEP+* are two separate assessments, each of which serves a very different purpose. *IREAD-3* was developed in accordance with HEA 1367 (also known as PL 109 in 2010), which requires the evaluation of reading skills for students at the end of grade 3. The English/Language Arts (ELA) portion of the Grade 3 *ISTEP+* test was developed to measure student achievement of Grade 3 ELA skills and is used to calculate state and federal accountability. While both assessments measure grade 3 reading skills, Grade 3 *ISTEP+* ELA measures both reading and writing standards; and *IREAD-3* measures only **foundational reading skills through grade 3**.

\*Applied Skills = “open-ended” item types, including constructed-response, extended-response, and writing prompt items
