



FRANKLIN COMMUNITY HIGH SCHOOL ALUMNI HALL OF FAME

The Franklin Community High School Hall of Fame was created in 2014 to honor FCHS graduates who have distinguished themselves. The nominee must exemplify the FCS Guiding Principles of *Communication, Individual Student Growth, Collaboration, Systemic Continuous Improvement* and *Trust*. The criteria are based on the nominee as a role model, leadership at local, state, national, and/or international level through their chosen career or vocation and/or society through their work or donation of time and have been out of high school for 20 years or more. Nominations are submitted to the FCHS Hall of Fame Committee in March for consideration of induction in August. Nominees will be kept on file for three years. Selection is done by a majority vote of the FCHS Alumni Hall of Fame Committee. A maximum number of two inductees per academic year. The selected inductees will be recognized at an induction ceremony and presented with a distinctive award. A display identifying the inductees will be on display at FCHS.

Criteria examples:

- ◆ **Academic/Career Accomplishments**
 - ◇ A respected leader in his/her profession (involved in career-related activities).
 - ◇ Demonstrated unique accomplishments within the area of their academic talents.
 - ◇ Recognized academic achievements at Franklin Community Schools and at the college or university levels.
- ◆ **Cultural/Performing Arts**
 - ◇ A recognized name in the performing arts or contributor to the promotion of cultural activities.
- ◆ **Major Contributions to the Franklin Community School District**
 - ◇ Promotion of the school's name and philosophy.
 - ◇ A major influence in the lives of Franklin Community students (by example or by contribution).
 - ◇ Distinguished contributions to the community.
 - ◇ Must reflect the FCS Guiding Principles.
- ◆ **Military Service/Public Service**
 - ◇ Recognized as having had a distinguished military career or accomplishments in the line of duty.
 - ◇ Outstanding public service accomplishments.
