Course Name	Course Description	Grade	Time Offered
Art of Animation	In this class, students will learn about the animation process, character design, and background design. They will also learn the history of popular animation studios and movies in this one of a kind educational experience!	3-6	AM & PM
Breakout: Crack the Code	Immerse yourself in daily escape room like challenges to open a locked box. Critical thinking, communication, collaboration, and creativity are only a few of the many skills you will practice in this session. Students will work as a team to solve a variety of clues and challenges, discovering keys and codes in this course. Will you "Breakout" and crack the code?	K-6	PM
Cake Boss: Decorating 101	Come learn from Mrs. B how to decorate cupcakes and cakes in an exciting and creative way this summer. It is sure to be a fun experience for anyone that loves cupcakes and cakes. You will learn how to write with icing and decorate with both, icing and fondant.	3-6	AM & PM
Crocheting 101	This class will be devoted to learning how to crochet. Students will learn the basic stitches during the beginning of the week and create their own project at the end of the week.	5-6	AM & PM
