### What is the Cub Pantry?

The Cub Pantry is a choice food pantry serving Franklin Community School Corporation employees, students and their families. Until now, the only food assistance students and families receive is through the Gleaners BackSacks program at the elementary level. Wanting to extend this service to the entire school corporation, Franklin Community Schools, in partnership with Gleaners Food Bank introduces its first school based food pantry!

The Cub Pantry is operated entirely by volunteers within the community and FCSC! 🐾

### Cub Pantry Location:

- The Cub Pantry is located at the Franklin Community Middle School
- Enter through door 24S located at the side of the building
- Pantry is located in room B128

### Cub Pantry Time:

- Open from 4-6pm
- Open the first Thursday of the month **unless** it falls on a holiday or a day school is not session
- Check with your child's school secretary or guidance counselor for pantry dates each year

### To Qualify:

- You must be an employee of the school corporation
- You must be a student or have a student attending Franklin Community School Corporation
- You must provide photo ID
- You are limited to one visit per month, unless otherwise noted
- There are **NO income restrictions**

**IMPORTANT:** The pantry will be open throughout the school year and summer months. If FCMS closes due to inclement weather on the same day the pantry is scheduled to be open, the pantry will also be closed. The date will not be rescheduled. Students and families will have to visit the following month.

## Cub Pantry Point System:

Each item in the Cub Pantry will be assigned a point value (e.g. one canned good = 1 point). Families will receive a set amount of points they can use to “shop” for any of the items in the pantry. The number of points is determined by how many individuals are in your family. There is no pre-bagged food; families may choose what they would like from the pantry.

### Point System:

- Family size between 1-4 = 25 points
- Family size between 5-6 = 30 points
- Family size between 7-8 = 35 points
- Family size 9 and above = 40 points

### Typical Items in the Cub Pantry:

- Frozen meat (beef, chicken or turkey)
- Cereal
- Rice/Pasta/Mac & Cheese
- Canned fruit
- Canned vegetables
- Canned meat (tuna or chicken)
- Peanut butter and jelly
- Hygiene items (toilet paper, paper towels, deodorant)
- Laundry detergent
- Diapers
- Fresh product (when available)
