What do you most look forward to doing during the holiday season?

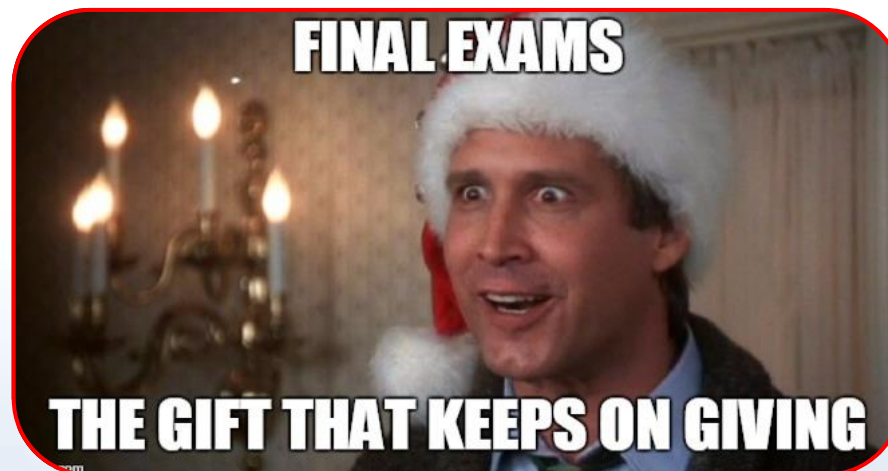
