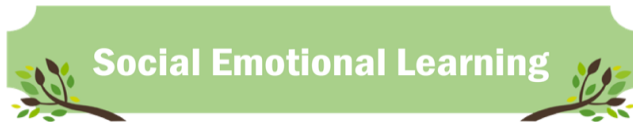
# Go Grizzly Cubs!
