

Frequently Asked Questions:

1. What time does school start? The doors open at 8:00. Classes start at 8:20.
2. Where do I go on the first day of school? All students will report to the gym. (5th graders will be in the small gym (Gym B) and 6th graders will report to the larger gym (Gym A). Your homeroom teacher will come get your class and escort you to your classroom.
3. What do I need to bring? A copy of your schedule and your school supplies.
4. How do I know what bus to ride? Your parents will need to download the StopFinder app. They received notification of this in May. If they didn't download it in May, that link will be expired. Another invitation should have been sent to your parent's email within the last 30 days. (It may be in their SPAM). If they did not get this invitation, they should email transportation at transportation@franklinschools.org. Once the StopFinder app is downloaded, your parent will see "no subscriptions available." That is because the site is not live until July 29th. On the 29th, your parents will be able to login and then scroll over to August 3rd, since that is the first day of school. There, it will show your name, your bus stop and bus number.
5. How does lunch work? You are welcome to bring your lunch if you would like. If you want to purchase lunch, you will need to know your student ID number. You will find this number on your schedule. It is your student ID number. The regular lunch price is \$2.90/Reduced price is \$0.40. The regular breakfast price is \$1.75/Reduced price is \$0.30.
6. How will I know how to get around? Your teachers will be walking you from class to class. They will also escort you to the bus or car rider line at the end of the day.
7. What if I forget my schedule? No worries! Your homeroom teacher will have an extra copy on the first day. You will just need to know who your homeroom teacher is.
8. What information on my schedule do I absolutely need to know when I arrive on the first day of school? If you know your homeroom teacher's name, you are all set! It would also be helpful to memorize your student ID number.
9. How will I know what is going on throughout the school? We have live morning announcements every day. These are linked on the bottom of our website daily so that your parents can watch them too! Upcoming activities, clubs, etc. will be announced as they come up throughout the year.
10. How can my parents keep track of my grades and assignments? You will have an agenda that you are expected to write assignments in daily and carry around with you at all times. Your parents can login to PowerSchool under the ParentPortal to access your grades. Many teachers also use Google Classroom.
11. Lockers...You will need to eventually memorize your locker combination. Your teachers will decide when your team will start using lockers.
12. Chromebooks...You must charge your Chromebook every night. It is your responsibility to charge and take care of your Chromebook.
