PE Opt Out Information

Please read completely and refer to our FCHS Course Description book for the full PE Opt-Out Policy.

One Opt Out credit will be given per FCHS approved sport or activity for one semester of PE. A student may only use one sport or activity once. **To opt out of a full year of PE, two qualifying activities must be used.**

One credit will be given per one complete season of an FCHS sponsored IHSAA sanctioned sport (freshman, reserve, or varsity), cheerleading, marching band/fall color guard, certain choirs, boys volleyball, bowling, or dance. A student may use a sport or activity only once. For example, a football player may only use football once, a second waiver would require a different sport or approved activity.

****Weights does not count as PE Opt Out waiver, it is just an alternative option to take instead of PE if you are in a sport/activity. Both PE and Weights are classes during the school day and will be listed on the front page with your other classes.**

****If you choose the PE Opt Out waiver of 1 or 2 semesters then you will have extra room in your schedule to take other classes of your choice. Please make sure your schedule is full on the front page of this form.**

To successfully earn PE credit through the Opt Out process, the student will be required to meet periodically with the approved PE teacher to demonstrate proficiency in the Indiana Physical Education Academic Standards. In addition, the student will need to pass a mid-term and summative exam that will test physical fitness, a written test, and submit a calendar listing physical activity.
